The leadership and staff of Jones High School value parent and family engagement and have put measures in place to offer parent meetings often and on a flexible schedule. Many of our parents are employed, so Parent Teacher Conferences are scheduled in the afternoon or on an "as needed" basis. Our Annual Meeting and Open House will be held in the evening.

Jones High School has a partnership with MVP Families, an initiative of Polis Institute and LIFT Orlando, the development company rebuilding the 1-mile radius surrounding Jones. MVP Families is exclusive to people living in the 32805 zip code. They meet once a month at Frontline Outreach (less than half a mile from JHS) and dinner and childcare are provided. The meetings have been temporarily moved to Citrus Sports until the Frontline remodel is complete. The purpose of MVP Families is to strengthen family ties and work together to improve the educational experience of children living in the 32805 zip code. The principal is updated on these meetings as many Jones families participate.

Home visits are conducted by our school social worker, guidance department, SAFE coordinator, administration and School Resource Officers ongoing based on need.
